### Welcome to the 2021 Mile High Showdown

Welcome to the 2021 Mile High Showdown which is hosted by the High Plains Practical Shooters club and Ben Lomond Gun Club range. We are excited to have the opportunity to host this match and hope that you have a great time attending the event. The items listed below are intended to be a quick reference for common questions, requirements and rules. This list is not intended to be a replacement or amendment to the USPSA Rules. This is a USPSA sanctioned match and we will be strictly adhering to USPSA rules. If you need more specific Rule definitions than what is listed below please reference the USPSA rule book for clarification. The match staff have put in a lot of work to make this match happen. If you have any questions, comments or concerns please contact the match staff and we will do our best to get you taken care of. Please be safe and enjoy the match!!!

**Rules –** All match rules can be found in the current edition of the USPSA Rule Book.

**Cold Range** – Be Safe! Firearms are not to be handled anywhere on the range except in designated Safe Areas or under the supervision of a Range Officer. Please do not handle your firearms in the parking lot or in your car while on the range property. Bring them to a Safe Area before handling

**Safe Areas** – Safe Areas are located in various places throughout the range for your convenience. Please use them. And remember - No ammunition may be handled in these Safe Areas.

**Eye & Ear Protection** - All competitors must wear eye and hearing protection while in a bay. Eye protection is required to be worn by everyone at the Range. Violators may be instructed to leave the Range.

**Assist the RO's** - Range Officers are here to assist you in completing a safe shooting contest. Each stage will have a dedicated CRO and RO. The squad will be responsible for resetting the stage (Taping, Painting Steel, Brassing, etc.). Help us help you run smoothly and efficiently through the match.

**Brass Recovery** – This match is not considered a Lost Brass Match. But if the squad is falling behind schedule the first activity that will be stopped is brassing. Please do not delay your squad by spending excessive time recovering spent brass.

**Chronograph** – A chronograph may or may not be used for this match. Make sure that your ammunition meets or exceeds the minimum required power factor you have declared.

**Visual Barrier Scoring** – All walls, barrels and other props used as visual barriers are declared as hardcover unless stated otherwise in the stage briefing. All walls are considered to extend down to the ground and upwards to infinity.

**Match Scoring** – We will be using Practiscore to maximize the efficiency and accuracy of the match scoring. We will have hard copy score sheets to record your stage score results. It is the Competitors responsibility to review and confirm your score on the scoring tablet before approving your score. Scores will be uploaded to the Practiscore website frequently during the match for competitors to review their scores online.

**Stay with your Squad** - We ask that you stay with your squad and be on time at your scheduled stages. Do not jump stages or shoot stages in any order other than that indicated in the squadding schedule without the express consent of the RM.

**Awards –** Trophies will be awarded to winners based on the USPSA Recognition requirements listed in the USPSA Rule Book (Appendix A2). The below tables break down our recognition policy.

**Alcohol** - Alcohol and recreational drugs may not be consumed anywhere on the range. Competitors or spectators violating this policy will be disqualified and required to leave the range.

**Dress Code-** Practical shooting is a family sport, please dress appropriately. The match director will be the final arbiter of questionable attire.

**Match Schedule-** The range will be open at 7:00 AM from Thursday - Sunday. The stages will be setup on Thursday. The match will be shot in a one day format on Friday and a two day format on Saturday – Sunday. Please refer to the match schedule for a detailed listing of the match time line and squad/stage schedules.

**Stage Inspection** - You may inspect the stages when the range is open, but you may not activate, set, or reset any moving targets or activated props. Please respect the match schedule. If you would like to inspect a stage during the match, and a squad is currently not shooting the stage, please ask the RO for permission to access the stage.

Physical Stage Configuration – This match will leverage six physical stages that will each be shot in two different stage configurations. Each stage configuration will provide a unique shooting challenge. The two stage versions will not be shot back to back. You will shoot the first version of all six stages, then the stages will be converted to their second version and you will then shoot all six stages of the second version. This means that you will travel to each bay twice throughout the match. Each stages unique Written Stage Briefing will be post on each bay. When inspecting the physical stage keep in mind that each version of the stage has special requirements defined by each stages written stage briefing.

**Popper Calibration** – Popper calibration will be according to the current provisions of Appendix C1 of the Handgun Rule Book. Please remember that steel plates cannot be calibrated. If a steel plate fails to fall when hit during the course of fire the shooter will be stopped and issued a reshoot due to a range failure.

**Arbitration -** Arbitration's will be handled per the documented processes listed in Chapter 11 of the current USPSA rule book.

**Drawings & Dimensions -** Drawings and dimensions shown on the stage briefing are approximate and may change due to safety issues or range restrictions. There may be additional no-shoots, vision barriers, or other changes. Inspect each stage carefully and listen to the written stage briefing read by the RO's. It is the competitor's responsibility to fully understand the requirements and restrictions of each stage.

**Bulletin Board -** Arbitration committee decisions, lost items, schedule changes, and other official information will be posted on the Stats Shack.

**Restrooms –** Multiple restrooms are located throughout the range. Running water is not available at the range.

**Food Service –** Breakfast will be available for purchase at the range in the morning. Lunch is provided for the competitors on the days that they are shooting the match. Lunches may be purchased by non-competitors as needed. If you choose not to participate in the food service offerings at the range please bring an appropriate amount of food and fluids with you to keep properly hydrated and nourished during the match.

**Parking -** Competitors and spectators are requested to park only in designated parking areas. You may not drive into the bays or from bay to bay with your squad. Please lock your car to protect your valuables. The BLGC Range is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

**Match Shirts** – Each competitor will receive one match shirt included with their entry fee. The shirt size you select on the entry form is what will be ordered. Once the shirts are ordered you can't change your shirt size. Additional shirts can be ordered at a cost of \$25 per shirt. If you want to order additional shirts please contact the Match Director (Charlie Perez). Extra shirts will not be available for sale at the match. Only preordered & paid for shirts will be made.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Shooting Area with toes touching X's. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area.



START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Targets T7 – T10 should be placed behind barrels so that they can't be seen beyond the 180.

RO NOTES: None

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing fully outside Shooting Area with toes touching X's and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing fully outside Shooting Area with toes touching X's. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area.



TARGETS: 14 USPSA

**SCORED HITS**: 2 Best per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Place side berm targets so that they can't be seen beyond 180 as shooter advances down range.

**RO NOTES**: Use No Shoots to Block the bottom target on all Right Side target stands.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Area A or B with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Area A or B. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Area A or B.



TARGETS: 16 USPSA

**SCORED HITS**: 2 Best per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: All Targets shouldn't be visible from single position or Area.

**RO NOTES**: Watch for barrel hits to properly call hard cover misses. Remind competitors that only Areas A & B can be used for this version of the stage.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Shooting Area with toes touching X's with wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is unloaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Shooting Area with toes touching X's. PCC is unloaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange and support hand wrist above respective shoulder.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area. PP1 activates Swinging Target T10. PP4 activates Swinging Target T11. Both swingers remain visible at rest.

Note: 1 Best Hit per USPSA target.



START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Per current USPSA Rule Book



RO NOTES: None

**SETUP NOTES**: Place single barrels so Targets T21 – T24 are not visible beyond the 180

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Area A with toes touching either set of X's and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Area A with toes touching either set of X's. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Area A or Area C.



**PENALTIES:** Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Targets T4 & T13 should only be visible from the extreme Left/Right ends of Area A. Block all wall ports for this version of the stage.

**RO NOTES**: Watch for foot faults while competitors exit and enter the shooting area. Remind competitors that only Areas A & C are used for this version of the stage.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Shooting Area with heels touching X's and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Shooting area with heels touching X's. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area.



**SCORED HITS:** 2 Best per USPSA, Steel KD = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Use Up range Double Barrels on each side of the bay to block the side targets from being seen beyond the 180.

**RO NOTES**: Make sure that the proper USPSA targets are blocked with No Shoots for this version of the stage.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing fully outside Shooting Area with toes touching X's and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing fully outside Shooting Area with toes touching X's. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area.

Note: 3 Best Hits per USPSA target.



TARGETS: 8 USPSA, 3 Steel

**SCORED HITS:** 3 Best per USPSA, Steel KD = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Targets T5 – T6 should be placed behind barrels so that they can't be seen beyond the 180.

**RO NOTES**: Make sure that the proper targets are blocked with No Shoots and that all of the "Left" steel in each pair is down/removed.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Shooting Area with hands touching X's on Barrels. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Shooting Area with one hand touching X on one Barrel and bottom of magazine touching X on the other Barrel. PCC is loaded.

#### STAGE PROCEDURE

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area.


#### **SCORING**

**SCORING:** Comstock, 28 rounds, 140 points

TARGETS: 14 USPSA

**SCORED HITS**: 2 Best per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Place side berm targets so that they can't be seen beyond 180 as shooter retreats up range.

**RO NOTES**: Use No Shoots to Block the bottom target on all Left Side target stands.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Area C with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Area C. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Area C.



**SCORING:** Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points

TARGETS: 16 USPSA

**SCORED HITS**: 2 Best per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Make sure that targets on the sides can't be seen beyond the 180 from anywhere within Area C.

**RO NOTES**: Watch for barrel hits to properly call hard cover misses. Remind competitors that only Area C can be used for this version of the stage.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Shooting Area with hands touching either set of X's on Barrels. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** : Standing inside Shooting Area with one hand touching X on one Barrel and bottom of magazine touching X on the other Barrel. Either set of X's can be used. PCC is loaded with muzzle pointing downrange.

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area.


#### **SCORING**

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points

TARGETS: 16 USPSA

**SCORED HITS:** 2 Best per USPSA **START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Swinging targets are locked into a stationary position for this version of the stage.

**RO NOTES**: Make sure that the correct targets are blocked with No Shoots and all steel is down/removed for this version of the stage.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing fully outside Shooting Area with toes touching X's and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing fully outside Shooting Area toes touching X. PCC is loaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Area B or Area C.


#### SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 26 rounds, 130 points

TARGETS: 13 USPSA

**SCORED HITS**: 2 Best per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Unblock ports on all walls and block the gap between the two forward walls.

**RO NOTES**: Remind competitors that only Area B and C can be used for this version of the stage.

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Charlie Perez

**START POSITION:** Standing inside Shooting Area with hands touching X's on center wall. Handgun is unloaded and holstered. All loading devices are placed on barrel(s) throughout the stage.

**PCC Start Position:** Standing inside Shooting Area with one hand touching an X on center wall. PCC is unloaded with butt stock touching belt, muzzle pointing downrange. All loading devices are placed on barrel(s) throughout the stage.

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

On Start Signal engage targets as they become visible from within Shooting Area.

Note: Magazines can be stowed in mag pouches or other locations based on division requirements after start signal.



**SCORED HITS:** 2 Best per USPSA, Steel KD = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Per current USPSA Rule Book



**SETUP NOTES**: Use Up range Double Barrels on each side of the bay to block the side targets from being seen beyond the 180.

**RO NOTES**: Make sure that the middle USPSA targets are blocked with No Shoots and Steel targets are down/removed.
